MISSION STATEMENT:

QUALIFICATIONS:

OVERALL RESPONSIBILITIES:

Responsible for Religious Education Program. To work with the Director of Religious Education in designing and administrating a balanced RE program that is adapted to the needs and interests of the Fellowship. Responsible for coordinating services which supplement and support RE programs, recreational and social activities of the RE group.

FUNCTIONS:

1. To represent RE at the monthly Program Council meetings.
2. To seek and retain volunteers for Children & Youth RE Committee.
3. To work in conjunction with director of RE to assure smooth functioning of RE programs.
4. To work with RE committee to plan & facilitate RE programs.
5. To oversee committees/individuals who accomplish these functions.
6. To develop an annual budget for RE and control expenses to that budget.
7. To oversee Child Care Committee, which coordinates paid baby sitters and adult volunteers for Sunday Services and all the Fellowship functions where child care is needed.

HUMAN RESOURCES:

RE Committee: RE chair and large committee consisting of many volunteers from the Fellowship. There are many small sub-committees addressing specific needs.

Teachers: many volunteers to teach and assist teachers during weekly services.

Child Care Committee.

Coordinators: oversee implementation of curriculum for each class and plan activities for each class.
