MISSION STATEMENT:

Is to implement and sustain social action programs for and with the Fellowship. This can include the functions of providing information, networking, advocacy and the establishing of a variety of local, regional, and global projects that are in keeping with the seven UU principles as defined by the UUA of Congregations.

QUALIFICATIONS:

OVERALL RESPONSIBILITIES:

To represent and facilitate the coordination of all the Fellowship social action programs, projects, and services. This includes coordinating all the Fellowship social action initiatives and keeping the Board and the congregation apprised of such action. Coordinate the running of the Rowland House, AIDS Care Team, Adopt-a-Room Program, Adopt-a-Highway Program, and Audrey's Closet (Thrift Shop). The director will organize committee meetings on a regular basis and will develop and allocate the annual SRC budget.

FUNCTIONS:

1. To represent Social Responsibility at the monthly Program Council meeting.
2. To seek and retain volunteers for the Social Responsibility committee.
3. To oversee running of the Rowland House.
4. To coordinate occupancy of the above mentioned temporary shelters by the terms and wishes of the congregation. Ensure that the house is in a livable condition after each occupancy. Ensure that the needed repairs are made and to assure the basic necessities are available. Continue supportive relationship with families in temporary housing crisis.
5. Adopt-a-Room program with Project Care to assist in renovating and "sprucing up" living areas for residents of Stephen's House (home for those living with AIDS/HIV).
6. Adopt-a-Highway to make sure that our stretch of highway gets cleaned at the three scheduled pick-ups per year (March, May and October), outreach for community environmental concern.
7. To oversee the running of Audrey's Closet (thrift shop). Coordinate volunteers to ensure that the shop runs smoothly and efficiently. Income for social responsibility programs and to provide items needed for the Rowland House.
8. AIDS Care Team ongoing program to maintain friendships and support for those living in the Greenville community.
9. To develop and annual budget for social responsibility and control expenses to that budget.
10. To attend committee meetings of other functions and organize special programs as helpful or appropriate to furthering the social action function.
