



## **An Update from the Board of the Greenville UU Fellowship**

### **Ministerial Search**

The report of the Search Feasibility Committee (which was approved by the membership at the December 13, 2009 congregational meeting) recommended that a ministerial search committee be formed in the spring of 2010 and that the search committee will determine how much of a search to conduct and who the candidate will be for "called" minister for our congregation.

If you are interested in being on the search committee or would like to recommend someone else, please see any board member for an application. The candidates for the ministerial search committee will have to be voted on by the membership at a congregational meeting.

### **UUWoC-GUUF Task Force**

The task force appointed to clarify and formalize the relationship between the UU World of Children (UUWoC) and the fellowship consists of Steve Compton, Jim Fowler, Maureen Nery, Jon Davids and Judy Root. They have been charged with "clarifying and educating the membership as to the history of the UUWoC and the current relationship between the UUWoC and GUUF, and ascertaining the congregation's level of support for the UUWoC going forward. The task force may use interviews, surveys, cottage meeting and/or other means they deem appropriate to carry out their task."

### **Chief Financial Officer (CFO) change**

Please join the Board in thanking Bill Schultz for his service to GUUF in many capacities, including his work as CFO for 2009-2010. Bill has notified the Board and the Finance Committee of his resignation as CFO, effective immediately. Chuck Lawrence, who was our previous CFO from 2007 - 2009, has agreed to serve in that capacity until the end of this fiscal year (June 30, 2010).
