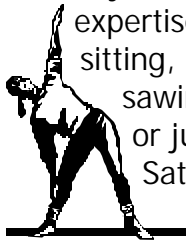

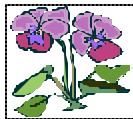
### Have an old laptop?
