



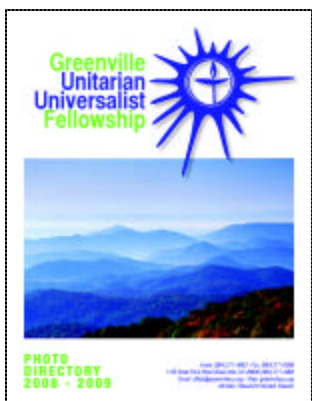
Photo Directory Information

For your convenience, with the Digital Imaging System, only one visit to the Fellowship will be needed to have your individual or family portraits taken and see the results. You can sign up for a scheduled time or wait for the company schedulers to call you for an appointment time. **We now have four dates:**

Sunday August 24th - from 12:30 to 7:00 pm
Monday August 25th - from 2:00 pm to 9:00 pm
Sunday September 14th - from 12:30 pm to 9:00 pm
Monday September 15th - from 12:30 pm to 9:00 pm

Sign up at Membership Table in Fellowship Hall before or after Sunday services for the best time to have your pictures taken. After July 6th we will send the remaining listings of Members and Friends to the company, First Choice Resources, Inc. to make the remaining appointments.

1. Every household who has pictures taken by the professional photographer will receive a free Fellowship Photo Directory (one per household).
2. You do not have to purchase photographs to receive a directory.
3. Only one picture of your choosing of the several taken by the photographer will be put in the photo directory.
4. Additional pictures can also be taken for purchase.
5. Prices for photos and photo packages have not increased for 10 years. The professional photographers in our congregation commented that the prices are very reasonable. Packages start as low as \$25.00.

WHERE IS MY UU WORLD??? **...ON ITS WAY!**

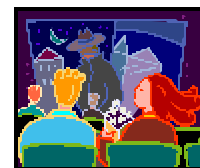

Greenville Drive Update!



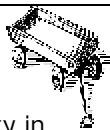

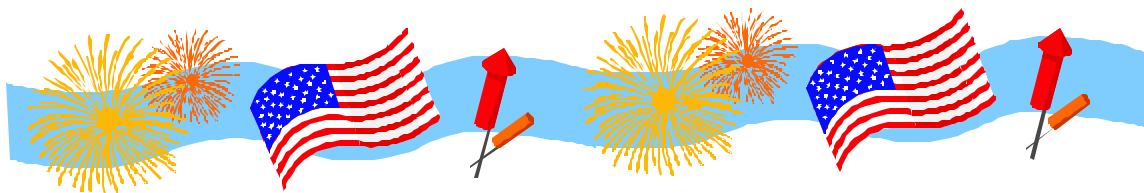


Nantahala River Rafting Trips
